Please find a step by step guide below to which will help you and/or your child(ren) prepare for your WinSport MMC Multisport Space visit.

Step by Step Guide for Multisport Users and Parents	
Before you arrive at WinSport	<p>WinSport will have limited washrooms available, we encourage users to go at home.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Please come 'Activity Ready'. This means being as dressed and ready as possible to participate in your activity when you arrive at the Multisport Space, to reduce time and touch points in the facility.• Complete a daily health screening checklist as administered by your Team/Club/Association ("user group") to ensure the user can participate today.• Participants must stay home if they are ill, even if it resembles a mild cold.• Participants must bring their own water bottle filled up from home and labelled with their name on it.• Participants are encouraged to bring their own personal bottle of hand sanitizer.• Review and understand the rules or explain the rules to your child so they know what to expect and can follow them.
Arriving at WinSport	<p>Users must arrive no earlier than 10 minutes before their scheduled booking.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Entrance to the Multisport Space is limited to the rear east entrance located by the MMC field, east of MMC (this entrance is subject to change and will be communicated by your Team Representative).• All user groups must check-in with their Team Representative before they will be permitted to enter the facility. This check-in could include the Alberta Health Daily Checklist and may include a temperature check.• Upon entering the facility, please use the hand sanitizer located at the entrance.• Upon check-in to the facility, a WinSport Team Member will ensure the permitted number of users are present. Any extra users will not be permitted into the building.
When in the facility	<p>Users will have 10 minutes to prepare for their Multisport Space booking</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Follow the signs and arrows when in the facility.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Physical distancing must always be practiced in the Markin MacPhail Building, including the Multisport Space, where only approved physically distanced activities will be permitted. • There will be no dressing room/change rooms available in the MMC/Multisport Space. • There will be a designated area near the Multisport Space to change footwear before the activity and keep gear during the booking. • Multisport Space users must wear masks upon entering the MMC facility until they enter the Multisport Space. • Spectators are not currently allowed in WinSport’s MMC building. • Parents must drop their athlete off at the designated entrance and will not be allowed into the building.
<p>Leaving the facility</p>	<p>After your Multisport space booking is complete, you will have 5 minutes to vacate the MMC building.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grab your gear, change your footwear and prepare to leave the building. • As you leave, please use the hand sanitizer located at the exit. • The only exit will be through the east exit into the MMC field east of the MMC building. Look for the signs on the door. Do not go through the PTC gym. <p>No loitering in the parking lot, please return to your car and we will see you next time.</p>
