WinSport's Tube Park opens Friday for winter season

CALGARY, Alta. – WinSport is excited to announce that the WinSport Tube Park will open Friday for the 2019-20 winter season.

The largest tube park in Western Canada will be open daily at Canada Olympic Park through the holiday season from December 20th to January 5th, with the exception of Christmas Day (closed).

Following the holiday season, the tube park will be open Friday through Sunday from January 10th to March 29th.

Throughout the holiday season, the park will feature seven double lanes with rollers (small mounds within the lanes) and six single lanes.

The tube park, which is located on the east side of the WinSport campus, provides an additional opportunity for Calgarians and Albertans alike to get outside and enjoy the winter season. Tickets can be purchased online at winsport.ca or in person at Canada Olympic Park.

In addition to the tubing lanes, the area features washrooms, firepits and a relaxing deck, along with a food trailer, which provides guests a menu that includes hot chili, soup of the day, snacks and other hot beverages. Adults can enjoy a cold beer or spike their hot chocolate or coffee. The entire family can enjoy the newest member of the WinSport team, Parker the Penguin, which is a marshmallow, chocolate and candy treat that can be enjoyed alone or with a beverage.
