# WinSport prepared to offer family activities as part of Alberta relaunch

CALGARY, Alta. – WinSport is excited to play a key role in the Alberta relaunch, with the opening of our mini-golf course and summer mountain bike camps, along with and indoor and outdoor weddings and events.

WinSport's professionally designed 18-hole mini-golf course is set to open on Saturday, June 13<sup>th</sup>, while summer mountain bike camps are now on sale, with the first week of camp beginning on July 6<sup>th</sup>. Our food and beverage team is anxious to get back into the kitchen as WinSport is ready to host indoor or outdoor weddings and events.

WinSport has been working behind the scenes, taking the time to understand the government's relaunch requirements to minimize the risk of transmission of COVID-19 infection. The safety and wellbeing of our guests, our Team Members, and the greater Calgary community is the top priority as we comply with the rules and regulations set by the Government of Alberta and Alberta Health officials.

Opening dates for the Performance Training Centre and the arenas, which were approved by the Government of Alberta to open Friday, have yet to be determined.

As a result of reopening requirements, many of the activities at WinSport will take on a different look from previous years. Here are some highlights:

### Mini golf

- The mini-golf course will be open on Saturdays and Sundays through the summer (additional dates may be added).
- Tee times must be booked online and are spaced 10 minutes apart.
- Only members of the same household are permitted to golf together at the same tee time
- Players are to maintain physical distancing of at least three putter lengths (2 metres) from individuals outside of their household.
- All equipment and putters will be cleaned prior to guest arrival.
- All high touchpoints are regularly sanitized by our Mini Golf team members.

## **Summer Mountain Bike Camps**

- All of WinSport's traditional camps were cancelled, with only mountain bike camps scheduled at this time.
- Camps will operate from July 6 through August 29.
- Camps will operate at a 1:6 instructor to camper ratio for all groups.
- Evening and weekend mountain bike camps are also being offered this summer.
- There are camps for ages 6-11 in levels 2, 3 and 4 as well as ages 10-16 in higherend Enduro camps for riders in levels 5+.
- Unlike previous years, before or after camp care, mountain bike rentals or camp lunch programs are not being offered.

# Indoor and outdoor weddings

- WinSport will utilize its 6,000 square-foot Festival Tent for outdoor weddings and events. The tent's side panels can be raised to provide for proper social distancing protocols.
- For indoor options, our 7,200 square foot multi-purpose room in the Markin MacPhail Centre has plenty of room to accommodate your group comfortably while adhering to all government protocols.
