Final weekend of winter season at WinSport's ski and snowboard hill

Calgary, Alta. – Time is running out for skiers and snowboarders to enjoy spring-like conditions at WinSport's Canada Olympic Park, with WinSport confirming today that Sunday, April 4, will be the final day of the 2020-21 winter season.

It is also the final weekend of operation for the WinSport Tube Park.

"We are proud to have provided exceptional recreational opportunities for Calgarians during this difficult time," said WinSport Chief Operating Officer John Sutherland. "Despite the challenges of operating a ski and snowboard hill during the pandemic and roller-coaster weather patterns, this season has been a tremendous success.

"Thank you to our passholders, lesson participants, our day-ticket guests and tube park guests for following COVID protocols and helping to keep our team and other quests safe over the past four and half months."

The hill will be open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. today through Sunday, while the tube park is open from 10 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. daily until Sunday. Passholders must reserve their time online, while other quests can purchase two-hour tickets in advance online. Tube park tickets must also be purchased online. All COVID protocols, including mandatory face coverings and physical distancing, remain in place.

Our onsite partners, Ski Cellar Snowboard, are offering 20% off all regular-priced merchandise through Sunday at the WinSport location. Guests must show their season pass or lift pass to receive the discount. There are additional storewide discounts of up to 75% on select merchandise at the WinSport location only.
