Sun's Out Guns Out Rail Jam helps wrap up final weekend of 2021-22 ski and snowboard season

CALGARY, Alta. – WinSport is wrapping up another successful winter ski and snowboard season at Canada Olympic Park this weekend, with spring-like ski and snowboard conditions and a season-ending rail jam competition.

The weekend is highlighted by the Sun's Out Guns Out Rail Jam on Saturday. The high-energy event, which has been cancelled the past two seasons, gives skiers and snowboarders an opportunity to show off their skills at WinSport's renowned rail park. The event, which begins at 10 a.m., features divisions for kids and adults in both skiing and snowboarding who can win cash prizes or swag. Judges will choose the top three competitors based on the best tricks, creativity, and enthusiasm. The Grom event (12 and under) begins at 10 a.m., with the all-ages ski jam beginning at noon, and the all-ages snowboard jam starting at 2 p.m. Participants may register on-site 30 minutes prior to each event.

The ski and snowboard hill is open on Friday from 1 p.m. to 9 p.m., and from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday. Guests can also enjoy a DJ off the back deck to go along with BBQ food specials.

It's also the final weekend for the Servus Tube Park, which runs until the end of the day on Sunday. Guests are encouraged to book ahead for a time slot – 10 a.m.-noon or 12:30-2:30 p.m. on Saturday; or from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Sunday.

Guests can also check out our final weekend EIGHTYEIGHT Bar and Grill special. For just \$10, guests can pick up several options from our BBQ grill on the back deck of the Frank King Day Lodge, including Spolumbo's sausage in a bun; burgers (including veggie burgers); BBQ brisket sandwich or grilled chicken.
