WinSport's ski and snowboard hill open Sunday; closed Monday-Wednesday

CALGARY, Alta. – As Mother Nature brings a blast of cold to Calgary, WinSport's ski and snowboard hill will remain open to guests on Sunday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. but will be closed Monday through Wednesday.

A decision on Thursday's operations for skiing and snowboarding will be made on Monday.

The Servus Tube Park will be closed on Sunday, but is expected to reopen on Saturday, Dec. 24th, which is the next scheduled operational day.

According to Environment Canada, temperatures and windchills will begin to drop on Sunday, with a Monday high of -24C. Tuesday's forecasted high is -26C, while Wednesday will begin with extreme cold and windchills before eventually warming up to -19C.
