

# TUBE PARK

## RESPONSIBILITY CODE

- 1. ONE PERSON PER TUBE SITTING PROPERLY.** Your bottom must be resting against the floor of the tube and you must be able to reach both handles to ride.
- 2. CHILDREN** must be a minimum height of 91 cm (36") to tube. Children between 91 cm (36") and 106 cm (42") must ride in their own tube and be with a paying adult who is in a sperate tube and holding onto the child's tube at all times. All children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult in the Tube Park.
- 3. FOLLOW ATTENDANT'S INSTRUCTIONS AT ALL TIMES.** Wait for attendants to give you permission to launch your tube. Attendants will inform you if chaining or linking is currently permitted (varies with conditions). Follow all instructions that attendants give.
- 4. STAY SEATED AND KEEP YOUR FEET OFF THE GROUND** until the tube has come to a complete stop.
- 5. EXIT IMMEDIATELY AFTER YOU COME TO A COMPLETE STOP** using marked routes. Do not cross other tubing lanes. Do not use your feet to slow or stop the tube.
- 6. SLIDE IN DESIGNATED LANES ON WINSPORT PROVIDED TUBES ONLY.** Sliding on tubes is not permitted outside designated tubing lanes. Tubes must remain within the Tube Park at all times. Other sliding devices are prohibited.
- 7. PROTECT YOURSELF.** Helmets are strongly recommended. Ski boots and hard-shelled boots are not permitted to be worn while tubing. Be aware of others sliding on tubes around you. Walk carefully as winter conditions are icy and uneven.
- 8. DO NOT RIDE** if your ability or judgement is impaired by drugs, alcohol or fatigue.
- 9. BE LIFT SMART.** Make sure you have the physical dexterity, ability and knowledge to safety load, ride and unload the conveyor. You must ride the conveyor to access the top of tube park lanes. Ask an attendant for assistance if you are unsure.
- 10. OBEY ALL SIGNS, WARNINGS AND RULES.** Keep off closed lanes and areas.
- 11. BE AWARE OF LANE CONDITIONS AND FEATURES.** Lane conditions may vary with weather and use. Lanes may include features (roller lanes).
- 12. COOPERATE.** If you are involved in or witness a collision or accident, you must identify yourself to an attendant or other WinSport staff member.
