### **WinSport's Canada Olympic Park closes hill due to weather**

Calgary, Alta. – High winds and high wind chills have led to the early closure of WinSport's ski and snowboard hill at Canada Olympic Park. The park will close today (Monday) at noon and will remain closed through Tuesday, Dec. 3.

The closure is for the safety of WinSport's guests and staff.

Environment Canada is calling for continued wind gusts, with the temperature expected to fall to -16C this afternoon, with wind chills in the -30C range. Tuesday's forecast also calls for high wind chills.

The hill will re-open on Wednesday, Dec. 4 at 9 a.m.
