Final week of winter season at WinSport Canada Olympic Park

Calgary, Alta. – Time is running out for skiers and snowboarders to enjoy spring-like conditions at WinSport Canada Olympic Park, with WinSport announcing today that Thursday, April 2, will be the final day of the 2014-15 winter season.

WinSport's scheduled close date was set for April 12, however, due to increasing temperatures the decision was made to close 10 days earlier.

"As Calgarians know, it has been an unusually warm March in the city. Although WinSport would have enough snow to move around the hill to stay open another 10 days, we don't want to take away from our guests' experience," said Dale Oviatt, WinSport's director of communications. "The next week is an ideal time to carve some turns and soak up some rays at the same time."

The park will be open from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. on weekdays and from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday.

All adult hill tickets until the end of the season have been reduced to just \$19.88 (plus GST). In addition, skiers and snowboarders can save 50% off WinSport's regularly priced 2015-16 winter season pass by purchasing before April 30.

WinSport's Impact Lab and Retail Store are also offering deep discounts during the final week, with items up to 50% off. All jackets and pants, along with all ski and snowboard bags are all 50% off, with 30% to 50% off select Oakley, Spy, Smith, Dragon and Anon goggles. Select helmets are 40% to 50% off, while Spyder sweaters are 30% off.
